ATR VERDICT: Any support for the Jessie Harrington-trained Rae's Creek should be noted as he was a good winner on the level last time, while Idlewild left behind some very modest Flat form when tackling timber for the first time at Sligo latest. Rufino was beaten a long way into third over C&D latest but at least has hurdling experience, though not as much as ELISHPOUR, who contested Pattern races over timber in the winter, without success, before showing up well in a Killarney maiden in May. His experience could be put to good use here.

Eight Till Late stayed on well to score at Limerick, where he won his bumper, so he may save his best for that track, while Up The Hill romped to victory at Roscommon last time, but had been beaten in handicaps off marks in the 90s prior to that. Grand Partner, a gutsy winner at Cork, completes the quartet of recent winners.

ATR VERDICT: RUN FLY RUN followed up a solid debut effort at this track with an even better one when second over C&D and Willie Mullins' mare can hit the top spot at the third attempt. Rathmuck Native was only a neck behind the selection here last time but has had plenty more chances so may not have the same scope for improvement, while Cliffside Park was a close third at Downpatrick latest and cannot be ruled out.
