**ATR VERDICT:** WHITEY O' GWAUN needs to bounce back from a moderate 7f effort at the Curragh 11 days ago but had previously shaped with promise over 7f to 1m1f. Dermot Weld's Dalakhani gelding is bred to improve over middle distances and is expected to go close if running close to his official rating of 89. Little King Robin was third behind Simenon in a Group 3 hurdle at Tipperary latest and is interesting now reverting to the Flat, while it would be a surprise if there wasn't better to come from Ballydoyle inmate Thomas Wedgwood, who disappointed on debut at Gowran.
