**ATR VERDICT:** MAID IN RIO continues to impress as she's upped in distance and left a big impression when demolishing an Ascot field by nine lengths over 2m last week. If truth be told, the winning margin could have been even greater, with her rider looking around for dangers as early as the turn for home and, under a penalty, the penalised Mark Johnston representative makes standout appeal while considered ahead of the assessor. Her stable have also won the last two renewals with Hurricane Higgins (2012) and Broxbourne (2013). Lieutenant Miller is 4lb higher than when finishing runner-up 12 months ago and looks the main danger with his stamina assured, although Ascot Stakes fourth Sohar also appears capable of figuring.
