Jonjo O'Neill's charge now has a 9lb rise to contend with but is expected to go well for a trainer whose string are in good form at present. My Lad Percy and Zama Zama both built up consistent profiles before failing to complete on their latest starts and have place claims if back to their best, while the fitting of a first-time visor could unlock some improvement from West End.
