ATR VERDICT: Expensive point-to-point recruit CHAMPAGNE PRESENT went under by the narrowest of margins on his debut under Rules and lost little in defeat when then pitched into Grade Two company at Cheltenham. The runner-up has since triumphed at the same level so the form is strong, and this can provide Jonjo O'Neill's charge with a springboard to better things himself. Buckthorn Timothy's Chepstow conqueror was left trailing in the aforementioned Prestbury Park contest last weekend so it may be left to Market Rase victor Desilvano to give the selection most to think about.

ATR VERDICT: KEY TO THE WEST bounced back to form at Uttoxeter last week, earning himself a 10lb rise, so he is well-in under his penalty and can capitalise. Dance Floor King proved his Towcester success was no fluke when making it two victories from as many starts over fences at Wincanton. He is 13lb higher but the placegetters have since registered three wins between them. Garrahalish underlined his love of Towcester last time, while French import Cold March - who didn't get far at Taunton - and Fond Memory can't be dismissed lightly either.

ATR VERDICT: From his nine five-day entries, Willie Mullins has whittled down his team to just Killutagh Vic, who was a good bumper horse and outclassed his Clonmel opposition on his jumping debut. He will do well to successfully concede weight to L'AMI SERGE, though, because Nicky Henderson's French recruit appeared a very exciting prospect when landing the Gerry Feilden as he liked and has plenty of experience to call upon. Emerging Talent pressed the selection's stablemate Vyta Du Roc in a Cheltenham Grade Two - a level at which the winner has since followed up - and he is the primary danger.
