ATR VERDICT: A Doll In Milan is better than he showed when getting stuck in the mud at Ffos Las last month and may improve for the return to a sounder surface. Irish raider Golan Road is thriving at the moment and is interesting now stepped up markedly in distance, though the safest option may be PRINCESS TARA. Peter Bowen's charge won as she liked at Ffos Las earlier this month and looks fairly treated on today's terms. She could have more improvement in the pipeline now tackling 3m for the first time.
