






ATR VERDICT: An enthralling race in prospect and a chance for BRISTOL DE MAI to get back on track. A facile winner of a Grade One at Chepstow over the festive period, he then ran a solid race behind a smart pair at Sandown. He will have learned plenty from that contest and can get the better of Glingerburn, who confirmed himself an exciting prospect when landing the Morebattle over track and trip earlier this month. He will find life tougher having to concede weight all round but he's clearly on an upward curve and merits serious respect. Intense Tango landed a Grade Two mares' hurdle at Doncaster and is feared, while Medicine Hat and Chieftain's Choice add further spice to proceedings.
