

ATR VERDICT: Malaysian Boleh was claimed by his current connections after scoring at Lingfield in February and landed his first victory for his new stable in style over C&D last time. A subsequent 7lb rise will make life tougher today, however, so of more interest is grade-dropper UPAVON, a dual distance winner that has dropped 1lb lower than his last winning mark. ATR VERDICT: CLAMPDOWN scored with plenty in hand over this trip at Kempton last time out and rates the one to beat now turned out swiftly under a penalty. Three Gracez signed off last year with a 7f victory on her handicap debut at Wolverhampton and is worth monitoring in the betting now stepped up in trip on her first start since October, while a stiffer test and the switch to handicaps could unlock some improvement from My Strategy.
