

Luso's Way makes her first start since switching from Shark Hanlon to Tim Vaughan and would be very interesting if the market speaks favourably.

ATR VERDICT: The Gipper sets the standard with his two runner-up finishes, while Majestic Touch was held in high enough regard to contest a 45k prize at Fairyhouse in April and he can post a much-improved effort. Big Touch and Court King are both interesting, particularly the former who represents Ffos Las chairman Dai Walters, but a chance is taken on MIDNIGHT TUNE. She represents a stable who do particularly well in this sphere and the 7lb and upwards which she receives off the boys will come in very handy.
