ATR VERDICT: Straight Right would be the pick of the three-year-olds but, while he put in a solid performance in the Commonwealth Cup, a mark of 106 appears to be stiff enough. John Gosden has a strong hand with Johnny Barnes and Remarkable in the field and the latter is the pick of that pair. The son of Pivotal ended his 2016 campaign with a second-placed finish in the Balmoral Handicap at Ascot and he showed some encouraging signs when sixth in the Hunt Cup last time out. That said, the preference is for EARLY MORNING, who could take plenty of pegging back now dropped in trip. The six-year-old did plenty early on in the aforementioned Hunt Cup, but he arrives here on the same mark as when he found only subsequent Group 2 winner Acclaim too good in a handicap last September.

ATR VERDICT: Spark Plug has improved plenty since winning the Cambridgeshire at Newmarket last September and comes into this having got off the mark in Listed company at Sandown on his latest start. Thikriyaat has plenty of ability but has clearly not had the cleanest of runs since his heart condition caused him problems last year at Goodwood. The first-time cheekpieces could bring about improvement but the vote goes to MOUNT LOGAN, who is extremely consistent in this company and his form last time behind Lord Yeats at Newmarket looks the strongest on offer. Best Of Days is the only three-year-old in the field but has to prove himself after a below-par effort at Royal Ascot.

ATR VERDICT: Tiggy Wiggy and Mrs Danvers are two of the last three winners of this event but there does not appear to be anything of their class in this open renewal. That said, the two that stand out are CORINTHIA KNIGHT and Maggies Angel. The latter only found one too good in a Listed race at Newmarket last time out but she started slowly and was outpaced early on over 6f on that occasion. If she does so once again today then she will struggle to make up the ground in a race that is likely to be run at a fast pace. Corinthia Knight was not disgraced in the Windsor Castle at Royal Ascot and appears to have been saved for this event since then. Debutante's Ball gets plenty of weight from the aforementioned pair and her latest run in a Group 3 suggests that she could pose the biggest threat to the selection. Those looking for each-way alternatives should consider Connery, Lady Anjorica, Lynn's Memory and Mother of Dragons.
