ATR VERDICT: DREAM ALLY drops in class after a decent effort in fourth over this distance at Wolverhampton last time out and the eight-year-old looks suited by the return to Polytrack. He is just 11lb above his last winning mark now, and he could account for Fantasy Justifier, who didn't get a clear run when fourth at Kempton 11 days ago. Frank The Barber and Firesnake are both consistent at this level and look best of the remainder.
