Pulsating finished a good second at Lingfield on Friday and should enjoy this step back up to 7f if turned out quickly, while Tavener outran lofty odds of 66-1 at Lingfield last time and would be a threat if replicating that level of form here.

He should prove to be just as effective back at 7f having received just a 3lb rise and can account for the other recent winner in the field, Brockey Rise, who needs to prove his ability at today's trip. Kheleyf's Girl went close last time and could be underrated on her first start for Clare Ellam, while it may be worth considering Darkest Light, who was a beaten favourite last time and sports first-time cheekpieces on this occasion.
