ATR VERDICT: Mick Appleby's CLASSIC PURSUIT has proved most effective over this trip of late, and the gelding who is unbeaten in three can keep his fine run of form going despite the extra 6lb burden. That rise in the handicap offers hope to nearest challenger East Street Review, who hinted that a big run is coming when third at Redcar over six furlongs last time, while Mick Easterby's Carlton Frankie is another who may be best suited by the drop in distance here and could get her own way if left alone in front. Paul Midgley's pair of Orvar and Orient Class are others who could surprise.
