1		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 64/1	CLOUDY LANE 11st - 10lbs Form: 6-9431F Trainer: D McCain Jnr Jockey: J M Maguire Favourite for this race 12 months ago but couldn't get it together and never looked likely to get any closer than his eventual sixth. Won a decent race at Haydock this winter but fell at the first on his latest run and has too much weight.
2		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 139/1	CHELSEA HARBOUR (IRE) 11st - 8lbs Form: U1F234 Trainer: T Mullins Jockey: Emmet Mullins Handicapper is unlikely to be on his Christmas card list after giving this horse - ninth last year - a massive weight to carry. Looked as though his stamina ran out last year and no reason why he can improve this time.
3		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 37/1	SNOWY MORNING (IRE) 11st - 8lbs Form: 32-56F2 Trainer: W P Mullins Jockey: A J Mcnamara Quirky but talented horse who ran a lifetime best when 3rd in the National last year. Looks to be about to peak and with a top trainer so has a very strong chance even though he has a lot of weight to carry.
4		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 84/1	KNOWHERE (IRE) 11st - 7lbs Form: 6UP-180 Trainer: N A Twiston-Davies Jockey: P J Brennan Sent off a 66/1 outsider last year but was just starting to get involved in the race when unseating his rider five out. Inconsistent, but has run well this season and is with a trainer who has won this race twice in the past.
5		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 23/1	COMPLY OR DIE (IRE) 11st - 6lbs Form: 211-P07 Trainer: D Pipe Jockey: T J Murphy Took to the big fences really well when running out a brilliant winner of this race last year. Has been gradually returning to form this season and will have been trained purely for this race. Has a big weight but will be spot on for this.
6		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 199/1	OLLIE MAGERN 11st - 6lbs Form: 255558 Trainer: N A Twiston-Davies Jockey: Mr S Waley-Cohen Inconsistent horse who has been running better this season on the whole. Can front-run, which is an advantage around here, but the combination of a big weight and a small horse is not ideal in the National.
7		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 199/1	STAN (NZ) 11st - 6lbs Form: 51P04P Trainer: Miss V Williams Jockey: A Coleman Won at this meeting last year but that was over less than half the distance of the Grand National and will need to stop for a rest at half-way if his stamina is to get him round.
8		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 18/1	BLACK APALACHI (IRE) 11st - 5lbs Form: F2-P151 Trainer: D T Hughes Jockey: Denis O'Regan Very impressive winner over these fences in November and then scooted up in Ireland on his latest start from Snowy Morning. One doubt is that he only got to the second fence in last year's National, but is a leading chance otherwise.
9		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 23/1	HEAR THE ECHO (IRE) 11st - 5lbs Form: 71-556U Trainer: M F Morris Jockey: D N Russell Shock winner of the Irish National last year and has been trained purely for this race so far. That said, he really should have done better last time (he was beaten when falling) and his patchy jumping will be tested here.
10		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 149/1	PREISTS LEAP (IRE) 11st - 5lbs Form: 47-7F19 Trainer: Thomas O'leary Jockey: P T Enright Keeps on improving in Ireland and any rain in the run up to the National will be very welcome. Has only had a light campaign this season, but he does have a big weight for what he has achieved.
11		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 8.2/1	MY WILL (FR) 11st - 4lbs Form: 132023/55 Trainer: P F Nicholls Jockey: R Walsh Hasn't won for two and a half years but ran a blinder on his latest start when fifth to Kauto Star in the Cheltenham Gold Cup and gets into this on a very favourable weight. Stays well, jumps well and has a great chance.
12		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 149/1	EUROTREK (IRE) 11st - 3lbs Form: 411P1P/ Trainer: P F Nicholls Jockey: S Thomas Has run just 12 times in eight years so has very few miles on the clock and did manage to win a big race over these fences back in 2006. However, he's too old for this race at the age of 13 and his chance of Aintree glory has surely gone.
13		AT THE RACES ★★★★★ Betfair 14.5/1	STATE OF PLAY 11st - 2lbs Form: 2560-14 Trainer: Evan Williams Jockey: Paul Moloney A high-class steeplechaser on his day who beat Ollie Magern at Wetherby at the start of the season and has been given a break since Christmas. Comes here a fresh horse and is guaranteed to stay, jump and act on the ground. Major chance.

14		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 29/1	BIG FELLA THANKS 11st - 1lbs Form: 322U13 Trainer: P F Nicholls Jockey: Christian Williams Has just run four times over fences so lacks experience big time. That said, he comes from a top yard, stays really well and has some very good form to his name so must have a decent chance if able to keep his jumping together.
15		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 179/1	MON MOME (FR) 11st - 0lbs Form: 218278 Trainer: Miss V Williams Jockey: L Treadwell Has been placed in plenty of big races down the years and managed to get his head in front in a decent race at Cheltenham in December. Unable to win since under more weight and that looks to be the same problem here.
16		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 79/1	SILVER BIRCH (IRE) 11st - 0lbs Form: 421/1P9 Trainer: G Elliott Jockey: R M Power Won his second race over these fences when winning the 2007 Grand National but then spent a year on the sidelines. Won a point-to-point on his reappearance but has then run poorly since and has a lot to prove here.
17		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 9/1	BUTLER'S CABIN (FR) 10st - 13lbs Form: 3F-8085 Trainer: Jonjo O'Neill Jockey: A P McCoy Looked certain to be involved in the finish last year when coming down at Becher's Brook on the second circuit. Put up his best run of the season when fifth at Cheltenham last time and has a leading chance unless the McCoy 'curse' strikes again.
18		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 45/1	OFFSHORE ACCOUNT (IRE) 10st - 13lbs Form: 111/U2-2 Trainer: C F Swan Jockey: D J Casey Could have been let in by the handicapper given that he showed very good form two seasons ago - winning at the Punchestown Festival - before getting an injury. Ran a good race on his return over hurdles and could be a leading player.
19		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 19/1	PARSONS LEGACY (IRE) 10st - 12lbs Form: 23/54-1P Trainer: P J Hobbs Jockey: R Johnson Tough and likeable chaser who stays well and will be at home if the weather stays dry. Won at Cheltenham on his first start but then ran poorly next time. Back from a break here but tends to make at least one bad mistake.
20		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 229/1	REVEILLEZ 10st - 12lbs Form: F8612/P0 Trainer: Jonjo O'Neill Jockey: M P Walsh Classy chaser a couple of years ago but has been nowhere near his best in two starts so far this season. Usually improves in the spring and has run well over marathon trips in the past, but jumping is a little fragile for a race like this.
21		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 329/1	FUNDAMENTALIST (IRE) 10st - 11lbs Form: 146P6P Trainer: N A Twiston-Davies Jockey: David England Trainer has a great record in this race, but he'll need to perform his greatest miracle to get this serial under-achiever into the frame let alone win.
22		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 94/1	GOLDEN FLIGHT (FR) 10st - 11lbs Form: 111133/3-0 Trainer: N J Henderson Jockey: B J Geraghty A top class horse in France where he finished third in the Grand Steeplechase de Paris and has joined Nicky Henderson with the specific aim of being prepared for a crack at the National. Will need to improve on his jumping.
23		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 29/1	L'AMI (FR) 10st - 11lbs Form: 8-14212 Trainer: E Bolger Jockey: R Thornton Once a high-class chaser who still has a bit of ability judged on his form this season, though he did throw in the towel quite quickly when a beaten favourite at Cheltenham last time and might not have the heart for this.
24		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 69/1	BATTLECRY 10st - 10lbs Form: 32-245P Trainer: N A Twiston-Davies Jockey: T Scudamore Not far off top class last season but has struggled in four starts this term. However, his yard was badly out of form for most of it and now they are firing in winners again could be a surprise package.
25		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 45/1	CORNISH SETT (IRE) 10st - 10lbs Form: 80-F128 Trainer: P F Nicholls Jockey: Nick Scholfield A certain stayer who has already finished second in the Welsh National this season. Could only manage 12th place in this race last year and will need a downpour for him to have any chance of improving on that performance.
26		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 219/1	FLEET STREET 10st - 10lbs Form: 42-P610 Trainer: N J Henderson Jockey: A Tinkler A decent horse on his day and has been twice placed at the Cheltenham Festival. Doesn't stay in form for long and after winning in December ran a shocker next time. Throw in serious stamina doubts and he's a rank outsider.
27		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 359/1	MUSICA BELLA (FR) 10st - 10lbs Form: 222187 Trainer: F Cottin Jockey: P A Carberry French-trained mare who has form that ties in with Master Minded in her native country. But gives the impression that the only way she will last this trip is in a horsebox and is likely to be going backwards on the last circuit.
28		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 69/1	CAN'T BUY TIME (IRE) 10st - 9lbs Form: 111314 Trainer: Jonjo O'Neill Jockey: N Fehily Enjoyed a great run of form this season and was strongly fancied on his first run over four miles at the Cheltenham Festival. Visibly ran out of petrol there however so it's hard to see him faring better over this even longer trip.
29		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 22/1	DARKNESS 10st - 9lbs Form: 13P/3P1 Trainer: C R Egerton Jockey: W Hutchinson Has very few miles on the clock and has managed to win almost 50% of his races over jumps. He returned from two and a half years off this season and won last time, but will need to improve a lot to be involved here.
30		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 27/1	IRISH INVADER (IRE) 10st - 9lbs Form: 323111 Trainer: W P Mullins Jockey: P Townend Trends fanatics will be against him as he has been racing over trips as short as 2m 2f lately. But go back far enough and you'll find form over three miles and the suspicion is his canny trainer has had this race in mind for quite a while.
31		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 11.5/1	RAMBLING MINSTER 10st - 9lbs Form: 6-56511 Trainer: K G Reveley Jockey: J Reveley Comes into this race in the form of his life and it's impossible not to like him. A great jumper with plenty of stamina and form on a faster surface, he looks to be in this off a real racing weight and is a major player for sure.

32		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 35/1	SOUTHERN VIC (IRE) 10st - 9lbs Form: 06U343 Trainer: T M Walsh Jockey: N P Madden This Irish-trained 10-year-old hasn't won for two and a half years but did run quite well over the National fences in November. Will have his supporters but is prone to the odd mistake and when it comes to the crunch is too slow.
33		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 25/1	KILBEGGAN BLADE 10st - 7lbs Form: 0P-1112 Trainer: T R George Jockey: G Lee Racehorses don't come much tougher than this chap and he's certain to keep battling all the way to the line. Could be the sort to really take to these fences and is likely to be a strong contender here - with any rain also a boost.
34		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 37/1	BROOKLYN BROWNIE (IRE) 10st - 6lbs Form: 124921 Trainer: J M Jefferson Jockey: P Kinsella Second over the National fences in November, but might have done even better on an ordinary course as he clouted several. Will need to jump better this time but did win his latest start well and has an each-way chance if it stays dry.
35		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 41/1	HIMALAYAN TRAIL 10st - 6lbs Form: P584P0 Trainer: J J Mangan Jockey: P W Flood From the same yard that won the National in 2003. Will stay forever and might have been short of fitness when fifth here in November behind Black Apalachi. Could have an each-way chance though recent form hasn't been that encouraging.
36		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 629/1	ARTEEA (IRE) 10st - 5lbs Form: 78017-0 Trainer: D Pipe Jockey: J W Farrelly Moved to National winning trainer David Pipe this season but it's unlikely that even David Blaine would have sufficient magical powers to conjure a big race win out of this one.
37		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 739/1	CERIUM (FR) 10st - 5lbs Form: P/59PP-0 Trainer: Paul Murphy Jockey: K Mercer Formerly quite a useful chaser but has desperately lost his way in recent seasons and is in danger of being lapped judged on his latest start.
38		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 109/1	IDLE TALK (IRE) 10st - 5lbs Form: 50-2473 Trainer: D McCain Jnr Jockey: B Harding Put up his best run over National fences when fourth in the Becher Chase in November. However, was only 14th to Comply Or Die 12 months ago and his losing run - which stretches over three years - is unlikely to come to an end here.
39		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 699/1	KELAMI (FR) 10st - 5lbs Form: 2F6-P70 Trainer: Mrs L Williamson Jockey: D Lavery Has a dreadful record over these fences - brought down at the first in 2004, pulled up in 2007 and got rid of his rider by halfway last year. Unlikely to improve on that record here.
40		AT THE RACES ★★★★☆ Betfair 189/1	ZABENZ (NZ) 10st - 5lbs Form: 232P5/11 Trainer: P J Hobbs Jockey: T J O'Brien Only made it to half-way on his last try in the National and will be having his first start for almost two years if lining up here. Very hard to fancy.
