The selection is open to further improvement over this trip and remains one to consider while operating at this level. Daniel Thomas was denied a four-timer in a 1m handicap here on Saturday but has to be taken seriously now lowering his sights. Jordaura, another eased in grade, looks a bigger danger at the weights and is feared most.

ATR VERDICT: Even Bolder has been threatening to score off this mark for a while now, without quite delivering, and preference therefore is for DIAMOND VINE, who has edged up 2lb for a near miss over C&D earlier in the month and looks capable of holding his own in a grade higher than this 0-65 banding. Catalinas Diamond looks the main danger being only 3lb higher than when scoring over C&D in November, while the popular and vastly experienced Dvinsky is respected on the back of yet another victory at his favourite stomping ground, Kempton.
