ATR VERDICT: Point-to-point winner MALIN HEAD made a successful start over regulation fences when landing a good-ground handicap chase over 2m5f at Folkestone last month and, having started on such a low mark, he must have an excellent chance of defying a 6lb hike in the ratings. Folie A Deux is up 5lb for last month's C&D triumph and this race looks a little stronger if anything, so perhaps fellow C&D scorer Ere Alfie will pose the selection more problems having slipped back to his last winning mark following a couple of moderate performances on unsuitably easy ground.
