ATR VERDICT: Well-bred filly SWING BOWLER made a big impression when winning bumpers at Wincanton and Warwick in 2011, and the fact they were seven months apart shows she can go well when fresh. Embarking on her hurdling career today following another 53-day break, David Pipe's inmate is fancied to maintain the trainer's excellent recent run of form. Charlie Wingnut faded into fifth following a costly mistake two-out on his hurdling bow over 2m4f at Doncaster but the experience won't be lost on him and a drop in distance here could see him in a better light. Captain Brown and Sonoran Sands are others of note.

ATR VERDICT: Lightly-raced nine-year-old SECRET WORLD might be worth another chance now his sights are lowered. He ran well in a couple of novice hurdles around this time last year and although pulled up in a hot handicap won by Celestial Halo on his seasonal bow at Newbury in December, he caught the eye performing with credit in a recent 'bumper for jumpers' at Kempton. Leicester runner-up High On A Hill will appreciate the better ground but is almost certainly going to need more of a test, while Hereford second Monte Cavallo may also need further having been more of a stayer on the Flat. Red Inca has also shown enough promise to be of interest.

ATR VERDICT: HASSADIN comes out best on these terms and can take advantage of a return to selling company. Michael Blake's charge landed a race of this nature at Catterick 12 months ago and although well beaten on his two most recent starts, a repeat of his narrow defeat at the hands of Grams And Ounces at Hereford in December could make him the one to beat. Hat-trick seeker King Of Castile must concede plenty of weight all round but he looked in fine fettle when landing a 2m7f handicap at Fontwell last month and appears the obvious threat to the selection. Blue Ronnie is relatively unexposed and could have more to offer having put in a career best at Uttoxeter recently, albeit in moderate company.

ATR VERDICT: Point-to-point winner DANANDY made no mistake on his debut under Rules when landing a 2m3f Fontwell bumper in good style last month and he looks a lovely chasing prospect for the future. He can certainly pay his way over the smaller obstacles for the time being and 3m on good ground will be right up his street. Barenger is probably the pick of the opposition having looked like a more demanding test would suit when a staying-on fourth on his jumps bow over 2m4f at Doncaster.
