ATR VERDICT: Paul Nicholls has saddled four of this last six winners of this race and appears to have another cracking chance with AERIAL. Either side of an effortless Ascot success, he ran good races in Grade 3 handicaps at Cheltenham and a 3lb drop in the ratings following his fourth behind The Giant Bolster last time gives him a solid opportunity to get back on the winning trail. Mad Max, a Grade 2 winning bumper/chaser when trained by Nicky Henderson, travelled with real zest before failing to get home on his debut for the Neil Mullholland stable at Haydock in January and could mount a bold bid if fitter for that first start since April last year. Rileyev rates a lively outsider at a track where he won in November. The other Ditcheat runners, Pasco and Woolcombe Folly, aren't completely out if it and Araldur is respected from the in-form Alan King yard.
