ATR VERDICT: Sent off a short price to build on his promising debut effort, TRICORN didn't disappoint as he cruised to a facile success over 7f at Wolverhampton and John Gosden's charge may have been underestimated by an opening mark of 75, with the step up to 1m possibly bringing about further improvement. Faience also got off the mark at the second attempt over this trip at Chelmsford and that form has been boosted by the third and fourth winning since. She rates a serious threat, with Marzouq considered best of the rest.

ATR VERDICT: VEENA arrives on the back of a 6f double here and at Chelmsford and is a previous winner over this track and trip. While she may not be the most straightforward, David Simcock's filly remains unexposed and a 3lb rise for her latest success may not be enough to prevent the hat-trick. Poppy In The Wind was only a head behind the selection at Newcastle and is a big threat off slightly better terms, while Ki Ki returned with a good effort at Newcastle last month and should strip fitter now.
