**ATR VERDICT:** STRATUM had some very solid form on the Flat for John Gosden last year and the son of Dansili went for 160,000gns at the Tattersalls Horses in Training sale to Willie Mullins. He makes his hurdling debut here and it would be a surprise were he unable to get off the mark at the first attempt. Youghal By The Sea won a bumper at Bellewstown on his latest start and can pose a solid enough threat, while Gagas Horse is capable of better than what he showed on hurdles debut.
