ATR VERDICT: FLYING ANGEL and Frodon both have to give 10lb and upwards to their rivals but both are classy enough to do so. Preference, though, goes to the former as he landed a Grade 1 prize at Aintree in the spring and the Nigel Twiston-Davies team are currently in decent enough form at the beginning of the season. Frodon himself was a revelation last season and it seems interesting that he has a first-time tongue tie fitted now. Knockgraffon has the potential to improve on just his fifth start over fences, while Black Corton has improved since going up in trip in small field novice chases but seems to have an inflated rating.
