Corner Creek scored over three miles here last time and has to be considered, although the burden of top-weight could tell when it counts, while Johnny Burke is an interesting jockey booking aboard Gillian Boanas' French Seventyfive who has threatened to get involved on his latest engagements.



ATR VERDICT: Gunfleet ran better than the bare result suggests when fifth last time on his hurdles bow and the bumper winner is entitled to get involved here, along with Ballygomartin who saw the form of his own bumper win franked by the second in a hot Ascot contest and wasn't disgraced at Cheltenham behind a useful prospect when last seen.
