ATR VERDICT: Brain Power has attracted lots of market support in the build up to this contest and all the vibes from connections have been very positive. However, he was held when unseating David Mullins at the last fence in the Henry VIII Novices' Chase at Sandown 42 days ago and faces a difficult task against the top-class UN DE SCEAUX. Willie Mullins' star gelding is well ahead of these rivals on official figures, he is chasing his third consecutive win in this prestigious event and looked as good as ever when running away with the Hilly Way Chase at Cork on his seasonal reappearance last month. He has conditions in his favour once more and can lead these rivals a merry dance. Kylemore Lough and San Benedeto are both Grade 1 winners in their own right but neither arrive in great form, while improving handicapper Speredek will most likely be found out at this level.
