ATR VERDICT: Hand Of The King should be involved with a clear round of jumping while Dinnie's Vinnie remains in decent form, despite being a beaten favourite last time, and he is unlikely to be far away either. Rightback Atya and Tiger Sam are others to keep an eye on but BANDON BRIDGE edges the vote. He left his comeback run/first start for this stable well behind when third over 2m5f at Thurles last month and there could well be more to come from the lightly-raced eight-year-old.
