

ATR VERDICT: MONOTYPE appeared to get on well with excellent 5lb claimer Donal McInerney in victory at Limerick last time out, and the former Roger Varian-trained inmate looks to be well on the way to paying back some of his hefty 52,000gns sales fee. He clearly doesn't mind soft ground, and could have too much for Miles To Memphis, who likes it here and ran an eyecatching race at Punchestown three weeks ago, and Burren Life, who probably sets the form standard after his third in a Grade 2 last time out.

ATR VERDICT: This can go the way of TORNADO WATCH, who could find improvement back on Irish soil for Emmet Mullins after a short stint in the UK with David Loughanne. Second at Hexham when last seen, he was just outstayed on the day and looks to be on a respectable handicap mark of 104 here. Smokey Joe Joe isn't getting any younger but did it well at Cork last time (albeit in a chase rather than hurdles contest), while Pump Road looks open to improvement and a 6lb rise for his latest Tramore win doesn't look too harsh.

ATR VERDICT: CADMIUM has clearly had problems since beating the now 135-rated chaser Call The Taxie in a maiden hurdle at Limerick 414 days ago, but he has time on his side at only six years of age and fences shouldn't be a problem given his size and scope. His three stablemates are also of interest, particularly Turcagua, who placed at Grade 1 level over hurdles and hasn't been seen since pulling up in last season's Allbert Bartlett. Timiyan makes most appeal looking away from Willie Mullins' quartet, although it seems a little strange that retained jockey Barry Geraghty, who is riding here today, doesn't get the leg up on him.

ATR VERDICT: Hand Of The King should be involved with a clear round of jumping while Dinnie's Vinnie remains in decent form, despite being a beaten favourite last time, and he is unlikely to be far away either. Rightback Atya and Tiger Sam are others to keep an eye on but BANDON BRIDGE edges the vote. He left his comeback run/first start for this stable well behind when third over 2m5f at Thurles last month and there could well be more to come from the lightly-raced eight-year-old.
