ATR VERDICT: Countess Cathleen turned in a career-best performance when fourth in a maiden hurdle at Punchestown last time out and should be thereabouts with a repeat performance, though of more interest is the third from that same contest, TELL ME ANNIE, who sets the form standard and was previously unbeaten in two outings between the flags. Bumper winner Decision Time scored on the Flat in October and is also worth a market check now back from an absence.

ATR VERDICT: GIANT SPIRIT was comprehensively beaten by his stablemate Total Recall when last sighted but he's dropping back into maiden company, whereas the winner is being prepared for a tilt at the Cheltenham Gold Cup. If he runs to his official rating in these calmer waters, Willie Mullins' charge should take plenty of beating. The consistent Great Khan may benefit from a first-time tongue-tie being fitted and has place claims, likewise Border Control, who makes some appeal on his Naas second in January.

ATR VERDICT: Monkshood should give it his best shot on the front end under Jack Kennedy but he found Grade 3 company too hot to handle at Cork last time, returning a beaten favourite, and needs to bounce back. His stablemate, Burren Life, was in front of him in second that day and commands respect, though it might be worth taking a chance on easy 2m3f Clonmel scorer MOONSHINE BAY, who is a 3m point winner and could relish the step back up to this trip this afternoon.

ATR VERDICT: FINTARA has been dropped 2lb since a disappointing run at Thurles in November. However, that was at a time the stable was out of form and it would be no surprise if she was able to produce a career-best performance now to get off the mark on her chase bow. Veneziano Springs has been on the scene the last twice over fences and the step up in trip is in his favour, while Monbeg Chit Chat remains with potential despite failing to sparkle so far.
