ATR VERDICT: Dynamite Dollars is the highest rated of these, with an official mark of 132, but his most recent form has been disappointing and a 10lb penalty leaves him vulnerable this afternoon. With that in mind, the preference is for FRENCH CRUSADER, who won a bumper in November and is entitled to improve for his hurdles debut last month. Canelo is another to note and Rocco cannot be discounted either.

ATR VERDICT: AIR NAVIGATOR was an above-average bumper performer and as a result he was well supported to make a winning debut over hurdles at Newbury recently. Things did not go to plan for the seven-year-old on that occasion, given that he unseated his rider at the first obstacle, but the son of Yeats can make amends this afternoon. Qaviy Cash is rated 85 on the Flat and has to be noted on his hurdles bow, while First Drift and Quest For Life are others to note.

ATR VERDICT: Plenty of these arrive here with valid claims but the marginal preference is for CEPORINE, who arrives here having finished a narrow second at Uttoxeter earlier in the month. That was his first race since May 2016, given that he unseated his rider at the start on his sole subsequent appearance later that year, and improvement can be expected. Classic Ben has to carry top weight but he looks to have a bright future based on his novice hurdle form. Early Retirement is another who arrives here on the back of some very good performances, while All For The Best and Ballycrystal Court have each-way claims.

ATR VERDICT: Band Of Blood was a very easy winner of a veterans' contest at Exeter having had almost two years off the track so the main concern is the quick turnaround with the potential for him to bounce after such a big effort. Indian Castle should prove a lot happier dropped back down to 3m and is on a fair mark considering his form this season. Killala Quay is 4lb lower than his last win in this contest 12 months ago but a chance is taken with top weight CAROLE'S DESTRIER. He is yet to fire this season but he will appreciate a sounder surface compared to what he encountered at Haydock last time and this looks the easiest assignment he has faced in a while.

There is every chance he will need the outing but he should outclass his rivals which should set him up nicely for a defence of his crown. ATR VERDICT: Two For Gold (sixth) and Hidden Glen (ninth) both contested a Listed bumper at Ascot before Christmas won by Didtheyleaveuoutto and the pair both hold strong credentials here. That said, this is still a good bumper on paper and they come up against the well-bred BEFORE MIDNIGHT, who made a good start to his career when winning on heavy ground at Bangor at the start of the year. A sounder surface will suit the son of Midnight Legend and he has Alan Doyle's 7lb allowance to assist. Stop The World has some smart point-to-point form having finished second to Brewin'Upastorm so warrants respect, while No Getaway is open to improvement being a half-brother to Grand National winner One For Arthur.

ATR VERDICT: SKIDOOSH showed a good attitude when winning on debut at Worcester and is more than entitled to be forgiven his run at Cheltenham which came on testing ground behind Crooks Peak. He has missed the bad ground throughout the winter and he looks capable of defying a penalty with the Ben Pauling yard back in form.
