ATR VERDICT: Crezic has a definite chance representing the same trainer/owner combination that won this contest 12 months ago while Whisperinthebreeze can step forward from his hurdles debut at Navan, where he finished one place behind a subsequent easy winner in third. At Your Ease and Smoking Gun are others to keep an eye but slight preference is for I AM SAILING. The Flemensfirth gelding has been purchased by leading owner JP McManus since finishing third on his NH debut in a bumper at Navan and being gelded and switching to hurdles are both reasons for potential improvement.

ATR VERDICT: CONTINGENCY built on her victories at both Tramore and Galway when finishing third in a competitive handicap at the Dublin Racing Festival. The winner and fifth reopposed in Listed company at Punchestown on Wednesday, finishing second and first respectively to give the form a boost, and Willie Mullins' mare can progress further to land the spoils here. Pete So High has yet to run a bad race and warrants respect receiving the weight-for-age allowance, while Minella Fair is much better than showing in Grade 2 company last time.

ATR VERDICT: FITZHENRY has been in cracking form, both in this sphere and over hurdles, and entitled to improve further for the application of first-time cheekpieces, he rates the one to beat. Another big boost to his chances is the fact that Barry Geraghty has opted to partner him over the owner's other runners Coeur Joyeux and Minella Till Dawn, who both hold solid claims themselves. Sutton Manor is much better than showing at Leopardstown and he could return to form in this lesser event, while Tout Est Permis also merits consideration on his return over the larger obstacles.

ATR VERDICT: Hardline appreciated the drop back in grade on his most recent start when winning comfortably at Punchestown on his latest start in a Listed contest and has to be respected once again. However, his trainer also has two other contenders of interest with Cartwright, a useful Flat horse who won well at Naas, and DEFI BLEU, an expensive store horse who won his bumper at Navan in December. Preference goes to the latter with this looking a very interesting place for him to make his debut over timber. Impact Factor has steadily improved over hurdles and should play a hand in proceedings along with Speak Easy, who disappointed in a Grade 1 at Naas behind Next Destination last month.
