

ATR VERDICT: Frankel colt SPANISH POINT finished last of 11 in the Irish 2,000 Guineas on his reappearance but now eased back into maiden company, Aidan O'Brien's charge rates the one to beat. Rated 84 on official figures, he finished an outpaced second in two 7f maidens last term, hinting that he may well come into his own over a mile this year. Hasimiyya should be all the wiser for the experience gained on debut and is nominated as the main danger, ahead of Merited and Rockabill.






ATR VERDICT: CIRCLING MOON has impressively notched up a Gowran/course (1m7f) double and, with Sean Davis taking off a valuable 7lb, he will be well fancied to complete the hat-trick. Temasek Star clearly likes this place, having won over 1m7f last July and struck the crossbar in a 1m5f handicap most recently. He warrants respect along with handicap debutant Lucky Icon, who won impressively over hurdles when last sighted.
