ATR VERDICT: BERLUSCA was an impressive winner over C&D when drawing clear of his rivals in an apprentice contest and can follow up, even with a 7lb higher mark to contend with. Ventura Gold has only risen 2lb for a victory at Musselburgh and can keep the selection honest, while My Fantasea is 1lb lower than his Wolverhampton second and warrants respect, despite looking much more comfortable on the all-weather. Fleetfoot Jack and Broken Force are two others to note.

The hat-trick seeking Bellevarde has to be respected, while Mythical Spirit was only beaten a length on her return to turf at Carlisle and the dual all-weather winner has to be on the shortlist, along with penalised Ayr scorer Economic Crisis.

ATR VERDICT: Warren Greatrex is 3-6 with his Flat runners on turf this year so any market support for Bodes Well would be worth noting, while Perisher ran well from a bad draw at Kempton on debut and should appreciate this step up from 7f.
