ATR VERDICT: A wide-open contest in which it may be worth chancing HAWKERLAND, who shaped encouragingly when third on his seasonal return over 1m6f at Salisbury and has since been dropped 2lb, putting him only 3lb higher than when scoring over 2m at Chepstow last season. White Desert and Star Of The East are respected now dropping back from 2m4f and 2m respectively, while the consistent Alqamar and C'Est No Mour, the latter of whom is stepping up from 1m4f, also merit consideration.


