ATR VERDICT: TEMPESTATEFLORESCO made a pleasing reappearance when fourth in a 2m7f hurdle race at Worcester before finding the Queen Alexandra at Royal Ascot too hot to handle. This represents much calmer shores for Colin Tizzard's 10-year-old and he can win again now stepping back up in trip over fences. Petrou represents a trainer/jockey combination that have been in great form throughout the summer, while Mighty Leader often goes well at this time of year but needs improvement now upped in class.

ATR VERDICT: SEDGEMOOR EXPRESS was below par on his first run in a handicap for over three years when finishing last over fences at Market Rasen, but returning to hurdles off 5lb lower could see the 10-year-old return to his usual consistency. Rise Of An Empire broke blood vessels at Wincanton back in May but the son of Stowaway could be freshened up after a 60-day absence, while Lord Topper looks best of the remainder in first-time blinkers.
