ATR VERDICT: BARGY LADY was far from convincing on her chasing debut at Sligo but the extended distance here gives Willie Mullins' useful six-year-old a chance to get back on track. Polar Present was one place ahead in third that day but has questions to answer having come to grief at Gowran Park last time. Creation would have a chance on her chasing bow if repeatingthe form of her one-length defeat by Dawn Shadow in a Listed hurdle at the Punchestown Festival, while a tongue-tie may assist Turndownthevolume, who has been seen mainly in the pointing field of late. Make My Heart Fly saw her four-race winning summer hurdles run come to an end in Listed company at Gowran last time and would be an interesting chasing newcomer if taking part, but has an alternative engagement at Limerick on Sunday.

ATR VERDICT: Sometime Soon comfortably won a bumper at this venue in February before disappointing in two subsequent starts, and the 2017 point-to-point scorer may improve for switching to hurdles, while the same owners have a strong chance with Jan Maat, second in a Killarney bumper last time. However, THE SHUNTER arguably brings the single best piece of form to the table with his third behind subsequent Cheltenham Festival third and Punchestown Festival winner Tornado Flyer in a course bumper in January, and he gets the vote to make a winning start to his jumping career.
