ATR VERDICT: ROAD TO RESPECT was successful in this race 12 months ago (Sub Lieutenant third and Outlander sixth) before producing four top quality performances at the highest level, including a fourth-placed finish in the Cheltenham Gold Cup. At just seven years old, he should be equally as good this season, if not even better, and gets the vote to make a winning reappearance once again. Sub Lieutenant readily beat Sandymount Duke on his latest outing at the Galway Festival and he can show up well here, while Snow Falcon warrants respect following his determined victory in the Kerry National last month.
