**ATR VERDICT:** RAHEEB makes plenty of appeal on pedigree having cost 180,000gns at the Tattersalls December foals sale in 2016 and being a half-sister to Group 3 winner Extortionist. Her trainer Owen Burrows is more than capable of readying one first time out and the daughter of Kodiak looks the one to side with. Orange Blossom has been highly tried throughout this season and could benefit from a switch to the all-weather, while Storm Blitz is considered on his debut for a trainer who has a fine record with his sprinters.
