Her trainer Owen Burrows is more than capable of readying one first time out and the daughter of Kodiac looks the one to side with. Orange Blossom has been highly tried throughout this season and could benefit from a switch to the all-weather, while Storm Blitz is considered on his debut for a trainer who has a fine record with his sprinters.

ATR VERDICT: Richard Hughes is 4-11 in the last fortnight and UNCLE JERRY has really boosted that record with consecutive victories on the all-weather. The two-year-old looks progressive enough to defy a 6lb penalty and the blinkers that have worked so well the last twice remain fitted here. James Fanshawe won this race last year and his Gaslight looks open to much improvement back on Polytrack, while Denis The Diva has shown steady improvement in his three starts to date and could be feasibly treated off a mark of 73.

ATR VERDICT: Horatio Star improved when stepped up to this distance at Catterick last time and looks one of the leading contenders. However, preference is for WOHILEH, who may have come unstuck at Chelmsford last time but can bounce back now returned to the trip she was only beaten half a length over at Kempton in September. The well-bred Referee is expected to build on his Kempton debut when greenness hindered his chances at the finish, while it will be interesting to see if Archie Watson can extract any improvement from the \$420,000 Galileo filly Rare, who has been a little underwhelming in her races so far while in the care of Sir Michael Stoute.
