ATR VERDICT: Those with previous race experience do not set a particularly high standard but Copal has displayed promise in both starts and he could go well. That said, the preference is for GREAT BEAR, who is a half-brother to the 99-rated Dubhe. The son of Dansili is out of an Irish Oaks-winning mare and she is a full-sister to the top-class performer/sire Nathaniel. So High is a half-brother to the European Listed/Canadian Grade 2 winner Utmost and he represents a yard who have a 36 per-cent strike-rate at this track with juveniles in the last five years. Madeeh and Hadeer are other debutants who merit market inspections.
