Coolagh Forest is another who displayed promise on his debut, while Liberal is another to note. That said, the biggest threat to the selection may prove to be one of the newcomers. Ghaly is the second foal out of a Group-placed half-sister to Giant's Causeway, while another of her close relations is the dam of Gleneagles, Marvellous and Happily. Fiction Writer cost 120,000 euros earlier in the year, while Stormbomber is a full-brother to a dual Grade 3 winner in North America and he cost connections 240,000gns in April.






ATR VERDICT: JAMES PARK WOODS confirmed the promise that he displayed in a very competitive maiden on his debut at Doncaster by filling second place at Newmarket last month. The son of Australia was only denied by a head on that occasion and he clearly sets the standard this evening. Metatron cost connections 120,000 pounds last year and bolted up on his debut over C&D last month, but he may struggle to give 7lb to the selection. Skyman should win races based on his first effort at Newbury but he still needs to improve significantly to take this race. Eightsome Reel is out of a dual Listed winner and he also shares his page with the top-class filly Zarkava.

ATR VERDICT: Those with previous race experience do not set a particularly high standard but Copal has displayed promise in both starts and he could go well. That said, the preference is for GREAT BEAR, who is a half-brother to the 99-rated Dubhe. The son of Dansili is out of an Irish Oaks-winning mare and she is a full-sister to the top-class performer/sire Nathaniel. So High is a half-brother to the European Listed/Canadian Grade 2 winner Utmost and he represents a yard who have a 36 per cent strike-rate at this track with juveniles in the last five years. Madeeh and Hadeer are other debutants who merit market inspections.
