ATR VERDICT: Trixster has won two of his last three including a narrow success at Chepstow last time. The highest rated in the field on official figures, he has to be given a chance, but SKANDIBURG may have more scope for improvement. Olly Murphy's gelding got off the mark at the second attempt over timber when running riot at Fakenham and shaped as though the step up to this trip would suit. Stoney Rover followed a Hexham win with a second at that Northumberland venue and is evidently in the form to have his say.

ATR VERDICT: This could be between the two penalised horses, with ENCORE CHAMPS preferred over Lord Yeats. The latter won nicely at Sedgefield last time but was well beaten by Warren Greatrex's charge when they met off level weights at Wetherby. The selection has since been beaten heavily in Grade 2 company at Ascot but should find this level more to his liking. Rollerruler showed up well despite his huge odds here last time and may be best of those without a penalty, but his form is a long way short of the two principals.

ATR VERDICT: Former Coral Cup winner Diamond King didn't really live up to his initial promise over fences for Gordon Elliott, but he showed glimpses of his best over timber last term and perhaps a change of scenery might help him. Both The Herds Garden and Diocese won on their latest starts but are out of the handicap so are both running off 17lb higher in this, so preference is for PRINCE CHARMIN'. Twice a winner over timber in Ireland for Tony Martin, his form had been poor before switching to Tim Vaughan but a couple of spins on the all-weather have appeared to spark him back to life.

ATR VERDICT: Dimple made it two out of two this season with an emphatic success over timber here last time but is up 13lb here, while Rock On Fruity has a 9lb hike to contend with following his smooth success over slightly shorter at Newcastle. Eureu Du Boulay is evidently improving and could be worth a try in this company, but this could go the way of MOUNT MEWS. A fair 10th in the Coral Cup last year when with the Jeffersons, he won a Grade 2 over timber here by 49 lengths back in the day and has room for improvement over fences as he makes his debut for Donald McCain.

ATR VERDICT: CHOOCHOBUGALOO was disappointing when beaten by a couple of outsiders as a short-priced favourite at Newcastle but the performance wasn't as much of a letdown as it first appeared because the winner has gone well again subsequently, and the runner-up has since gone one better. Sam England's mare is given another chance but Irish raider Bracka Lily bounced back to form at Down Royal and is a big danger, and Rose's In The Rain is interesting on her first appearance for Donald McCain.

ATR VERDICT: Lough Derg Jewel regained the winning thread in a three-runner Doncaster affair but the form may not amount to too much, and he has to compete from a career-high figure now.
