ATR VERDICT: It might pay to side with SE MO LAOCH in what looks a tricky puzzle for punters to solve. The eight-year-old has been running consistently well for a number of months, gets on well with this jockey (won and placed twice in three starts), and another bold bid is expected. Snugsborough Hall chased home the selection here and backed that up with another solid placed effort at Down Royal. He is likely to be in the shake-up again, while handicap debutant Whisperinthebreeze and Major Destination, equipped with first-time blinkers, are just a couple more with claims.
