The gelded son of Coach Dream signed off his Irish career with a couple of satisfactory performances in nurseries, and the switch to the Roger Fell team could spark the necessary improvement.

ATR VERDICT: VERY HONEST has found only one too strong on each of his last two appearances, most recently when the bang in-form Deeds Not Words chinned him on the line at Lingfield last Wednesday. He is turned out quickly off the same mark and deserves to get his head in front. Time To Reason went down by the narrowest of margins over 5f here and will appreciate the extra furlong, while Santafiora accounted for Carpet Time over C&D but is 3lb worse off.

ATR VERDICT: DARK ALLIANCE had two and a half lengths in hand of Secondo when they took minor honours in a track-and-trip handicap and although he competes on 4lb worse terms now, he should be able to confirm his superiority. Misty Birnam was just behind Secondo in a claimer here last month and is weighted to reverse the form. Majestic Moon faces his easiest assignment for some time, and Fast Track also has to enter the equation because he is better off with Dark Alliance and Secondo after running behind them here.

ATR VERDICT: There would be no more deserving winner than Simple Thought following a string of commendable performances in defeat and she had Tofan behind her at Kempton most recently, although that third placing represented an excellent start to the career of Marco Botti's colt. ATR VERDICT: Michele Strogoff was a length and a position ahead of Dragon Mall when chasing home a couple of triple-figure-rated opponents in a C&D conditions race, which helped banish his previous disappointment to the memory.
