









ATR VERDICT: HUMBLE HERO wasn't disgraced on his hurdling debut when second to a useful type of Ben Pauling's at Leicester last month and that experience won't be lost on him. A solid handicapper on the Flat for William Haggas, this track should play to his strengths and he could prove too strong for the likes of War Chief, who was lightly raced on the level, and Uttoxeter juvenile winner Idilico.

ATR VERDICT: Kumatana has failed to complete her last two starts over fences, both of those efforts coming at Wincanton, so a clear round is paramount for Nicky Henderson's mare. She also has 6lb to give away to both of her rivals, including Listed hurdle winner BRILLARE MOMENTO. She makes her chasing debut here and, likely to have been well schooled by connections, a bold bid is expected. Little Miss Poet finished runner-up on her first try over fences on Boxing Day at Wincanton and can only improve from that experience.

ATR VERDICT: RAPPER improved from his hurdling debut at Bangor when finishing third at the same track last month to the same winner, The Some Dance Kid, and he warrants the utmost respect running at his trainer's local track. Stop The World shaped as though he needed the run on his first outing over timber at Chepstow last month and can improve for that effort, while Monk's View could be in the mix after his fourth to Kapcorse at Wincanton 12 days ago.

ATR VERDICT: WHOSHOTWHO shaped as though he didn't see out 2m7f when third to Daklondike at Haydock just before Christmas so the drop to 2m4f looks ideal for Dr Richard Newland's gelding. He will be more at home on a sounder surface and could be suited by a return to a right-handed track. Gortroe Joe can improve from what he showed on his chase debut at Ascot last month, while Truckers Highway is respected as he bids to land the hat-trick.

ATR VERDICT: BUCK'S BIN'S won well between the flags in Ireland in October and he has to be given the utmost respect today, having been subsequently purchased for 60,000 pounds. Getariver is another Irish point-to-point winner and cost 30,000 pounds in November, so he looks an obvious threat to the selection. Honourmission represents a yard who can get one ready first time out and he merits a market check.
