**ATR VERDICT:** The form of SNAPDRAGON FIRE's latest second over C&D looks rock solid with the winner placing in a competitive heat on his next start and the third and fourth finishing in the mix in Kempton's Lanzarote Hurdle at the weekend. Tom Lacey's gelding is just 5lb higher now and the yard have been in good form this term. Highest Sun, a dual winner in France, has made a bright start to life with Colin Tizzard, placed behind two top novices at Ascot before fairing respectably in a race won by the runaway Al Dancer at Cheltenham. He should have more to come in handicaps and is noted here, along with Exeter winner Peterborough and Tom George's Casa Tall.
