ATR VERDICT: Sandymount was second in a useful Market Rasen handicap when last seen and would have every chance if in the same form following 18 months off the track, while Honest Vic also struck the crossbar last time. However, a chance is for PINEAPPLE RUSH, who won well in two novice contests during the spring and could leave her last couple of efforts behind following wind surgery in late November. Jumping has let Shillingsworth down the last twice but he could easily get involved with a clear round, while Buywise looked booked for a place on the podium when a last-fence faller in the Veterans' Final at Sandown and makes plenty of appeal reverting to hurdles off a 13lb lower mark.

ATR VERDICT: Thistle Do Nicely has scored nicely over both course and distance and at Wetherby so far this winter, before running with credit in Grade 2 company at Ascot last time, and he sets a useful standard. However, ELUSIVE BELLE makes plenty of appeal on her debut for the Seven Barrow's handler having transferred for 180,000 pounds following a narrow defeat in a Listed bumper at Gowran in October. Paul Nicholls often does well at his local track and therefore his J P McManus newcomer Nineohtwooneoh has to be respected, while Taunton winner Envole Toi and point-to-point graduate Win My Wings are others who could make the frame.

ATR VERDICT: The form of SNAPDRAGON FIRE's latest second over C&D looks rock solid with the winner placing in a competitive heat on his next start and the third and fourth finishing in the mix in Kempton's Lanzarote Hurdle at the weekend. Tom Lacey's gelding is just 5lb higher now and the yard have been in good form this term. Highest Sun, a dual winner in France, has made a bright start to life with Colin Tizzard, placed behind two top novices at Ascot before fairing respectably in a race won by the runaway Al Dancer at Cheltenham. He should have more to come in handicaps and is noted here, along with Exeter winner Peterborough and Tom George's Casa Tall.

ATR VERDICT: Potters Corner caused a surprise when scoring here on Boxing Day but is still well treated following a 7lb rise and could get involved again. Belmont's fine run of form came to an end when pulling up here in the Badger Ales but the competition is easier this time, while the novice Gunfleet has took well to fences and looks a smart stayer. 
