**ATR VERDICT:** Wolfcatcher was a comfortable 19-length winner of a small-field affair at Musselburgh in December and is sure to be popular on the back of that off a 5lb higher rating. However, it may pay to side with ECU DE LA NOVERIE, who has a wealth of chasing experience in France and accounted for the talented Mr Fisher on his UK debut at Newbury in November. He hasn't been beaten far in two runs since and remains on a workable mark. Un Prophete has to be respected for the in-form Venetia Williams team, while the best may yet to be seen in this discipline for Risk And Roll.

**ATR VERDICT:** Jumping errors cost Jester Jet in a Warwick Listed contest over fences last time, so it is no surprise to see her reverting to timber here. The return to three miles could be in her favour, but she may be vulnerable to a more progressive rival such as CULTURE DE SIVOLA, who has won three of her last four and the stable has been among the winners of late. If You Say Run is a useful operator who has placed in both Grade 2 and Listed company and will enjoy conditions, while Irish raider Magic Of Light won't have made the trip over to make up the numbers and is of real interest following a similar success on a raiding mission to Newbury in December.
