ATR VERDICT: SILVER STREAK has progressed through the handicap ranks over the last three seasons and took his form to the next level when second behind Brain Power in the International Hurdle last time (Western Ryder third). This contest lacks the strength of that Cheltenham assignment and a repeat performance may well suffice. Mohaayed had Western Ryder back in third when returning to winning ways in a Grade 3 handicap at Ascot last month but he is 4lb worse off with that rival on these terms.

ATR VERDICT: OTAGO TRAIL is just 2lb higher than when chasing home Bristol De Mai in this in 2017 and proved he still retained ability when placing in Newcastle's Rehearsal Chase earlier in the season and then running well at Ascot recently. Hugh Nugent removes a handy 7lb and the stable couldn't be in any better form. Colin Tizzard took this contest last season and relies on the returning Robinsfirth this time around, who hasn't been seen since scoring at Cheltenham in December 2017, while Captain Redbeard, a silver medallist off the same mark in this last term, is foolish to rule out at this venue. Only a length separated Daklondike and Ballyarthur when they were first and second here in December and can't be ignored, while Red Infantry has been in good order in staying contests this season, but may need an even bigger test of stamina than this distance offers.
