ATR VERDICT: Like many from the Sue Smith stable, TROOBLUE showed a fantastic attitude when winning a class 4 handicap over C&D recently and a 5lb rise probably won't be enough to anchor her if arriving in the same determined mood. Steel City posted a solid third-placed effort over hurdles at Catterick latest and he warrants respect switching back to fences with a first-time tongue-tie equipped, while Domestic Diva merits consideration just 1lb higher than when placed on her chasing bow.

ATR VERDICT: Wetherby third Ingleby Hollow warrants plenty of respect with Richard Johnson coming in for the ride, while Torrid has placed in both hurdle starts thus far and is likely to be in the shake-up again. However, it could pay to take a chance on NH debutant TAGUR. The five-year-old has been in cracking form on the Flat recently, winning twice and finishing runner-up in his last three starts, and Kevin Ryan does very well with the few jumps runners that he sends out.

ATR VERDICT: Winning pointer HILL SIXTEEN, an expensive six-figure recruit to Sue Smith's Craiglands base, has been involved at the business end in all three outings over hurdles so far, and despite looking sure to be suited by a step up to three miles in the future, could have too much class here for his rivals representing a yard which won this contest last season. Windsor Avenue landed a bumper here last year and has chased home some useful rivals in between a comfortable win at Hexham in November. Kelso bumper winner Romeo Brown, who was third in a Listed affair at Cheltenham on his debut, is of interest on his first start for Philip Kirby, while Massini Man has some smart form to his name and needs respect.
