ATR VERDICT: The smooth-travelling CAPTAIN CARGO bumped into a well-handicapped rival last time when picking up his second silver medal in a row over this course and distance, but Caroline Bailey's lightly-raced seven-year-old is still feasibly treated and is likely to be thereabouts at the finish over a distance he clearly enjoys. Book of Gold has always been held in high regard but is yet to fulfil his promise on the track and he is interesting back over hurdles having struggled in two outings over the larger obstacles. Ocean Cove is a dour stayer and Fergal O'Brien's consistent performer is respected on his first outing since wind surgery, with Oh Land Abloom also of interest off a mark just 1lb higher than when second in a Pertemps qualifier over a furlong shorter here earlier this month.

ATR VERDICT: SHANTOU FLYER was just a neck away from Cheltenham Festival success in the Ultima last season and was last seen running well for a long way in the Grand National. He makes his first start now in the colours of David Maxwell, with his enthusiastic owner in the saddle, and the nine-year-old could prove to be a cut above in this sphere, especially if a summer wind operation has had the desired effect. Double Ross' best days are perhaps behind him but he has enough ability to play a part at this level, while Cousin Pete was third in the Foxhunter at the Festival and the route to Prestbury Park starts here for Elizabeth Brown's 11-year-old, who opened his lungs in a Barbury point in December.
