ATR VERDICT: LORNA COLE has won two of her three starts in novice company, the latest of which came under a penalty at Newcastle. William Muir's filly had a 67-rated rival almost eight lengths back in fourth that day so a mark of 75 for her handicap bow might underestimate her. Dragon Beat went close in a four-runner event here recently and has claims off just 1lb higher, while Irish raider Annabelle Rock has to be considered on the back of her emphatic Dundalk success.
