ATR VERDICT: BRANDON shaped as though a step back up in trip would suit when a fast-finishing second over 6f at Wolverhampton latest and might not be badly treated off a mark of 77 on his first start since being gelded. Ballistic continues to knock on the door and he looks sure to be in the shake-up again, while French Twist, who has been placed on her last couple of starts, and Stay Forever, who didn't appear to see out the extended 1m1f trip at Wolverhampton last time, are others to note.

ATR VERDICT: Red Alert impressively notched a double at Bath before his break and warrants plenty of respect switching back to the all-weather, but other last-start scorer CHOICE ENCOUNTER shades the verdict. Archie Watson's charge looked to win a shade cosily over C&D two weeks ago (National Glory third) and a 2lb rise may be lenient. Global Tango is arguably the most interesting runner in the line-up with only five runs under his belt and he is entitled to improve for his comeback fifth at Newcastle.










ATR VERDICT: Unit of Assessment was a three-length winner over 1m4f here eight days ago but he is vulnerable under a 6lb penalty, with that leaving him 4lb badly in at these weights. With that in mind, the preference is for MY BROTHER MIKE, who beat that rival over C&D earlier in the month and is 4lb better off today. Baasha and Sir Prize are other recent winners who merit respect.
